Summary Statement/Background:

As the Council has received a Referendum Ordinance on this topic that will be placed on the 2020 ballot, it is prudent of the City Council to be proactive on repealing PMC 5.32. When marijuana businesses were initially prohibited within City Limits, the marijuana industry was new to Alaska and there were many uncertainties.
