Summary Statement/Background:

The City of Togiak has reached out to the Palmer Police Department (PPD) requesting PPD to providing field training, that is mandated by Alaska Police Standard Council, to their new police officer. Togiak does not have a Field Training program and therefore lacks the ability to provide the required training on their own. PPD has numerous Field Training Officers and has adequate staff to currently assist Togiak with field training their officer. The purpose of field training is to teach and monitor a recruit's ability to make decisions and how to apply the knowledge they've gained, from an academy/classroom training, into real life situations.
