July 22-28, 2019

On July 22, 2019, Palmer Police arrested SHANE R. CHURCH, age 23 of Quinhagak, on a No Bail Warrant for Assault. He was remanded to Mat-Su Pretrial.

On July 23, 2019, RANDY KURTZE, age 32 of Wasilla, was arrested for Theft 2. He also had a warrant for his arrest for Failure to Appear at an ASAP Hearing on an Original Charge of Driving Under the Influence. He was remanded to Mat-Su Pretrial without bail.
