September 7-13, 2015

On September 7, 2015, Palmer Police arrested DAVID M. HOWARD, age 24 of Anchorage, for two counts of Assault 3 at the Alaska State Fair. HOWARD was remanded to Mat-Su Pretrial where bail was set at \$750.00 appearance bond and a \$500.00 cash performance bond.

On September 7, 2015, Palmer Police Department issued an Amber Alert for a 6 year old child named Zion Barnes. Zion disappeared from the Alaska State Fairgrounds in the company of his mother, who is a non-custodial parent. The child was located in a motel in downtown Anchorage by Anchorage Police Officers who were following leads developed by the Palmer Police Department. He was unhurt and in good health. He was returned to his rightful custodians.

On September 8, 2015, Palmer Police received a report of a broken window at 112 S. Alaska St. The estimated cost to repair the damage was in excess of \$300.

On September 9, 2015, Palmer Police responded to a motor vehicle collision at the intersection of Alaska Street and Dogwood Avenue. The drivers were identified as PAIGE MARIE RABY KESSLER, age 25 of Palmer, and IMRAN CHAUDHRY, age 24 of Palmer. There were no reported injuries.

On September 11, 2015 Palmer Police arrested JOSEPHINE ARCHULETA, age 19 of Palmer, for Assault, Minor Consuming Alcohol, Disorderly Conduct and Providing False Information. She was remanded to Mat-Su Pretrial where bail was set at \$800, per the bail schedule.

On September 11, 2015, Palmer Police arrested a 41 year old man from Palmer, for Criminal Mischief 5 a crime of Domestic Violence. He was remanded to Mat-Su Pretrial without bail.
