### **Reminder Concerning Fireworks in the City of Palmer**

The City of Palmer allows residents to discharge class C common fireworks in the City limits, without a permit, on private property with the permission of the property owner, and under the direct supervision of a person 21 years or older, for four hours on New Year's Eve. You may discharge fireworks from 9 pm on New Year's Eve to 1 am on New Year's Day. (Palmer Municipal Code 8.40.040)

Please note that fireworks may not be discharged within 250 feet of any health care facility, assisted living facility, library, school, or place of worship. Fireworks may not be discharged within 500 feet of any automotive station or other premises where flammable liquids or gases are stored; within or from any structure or vehicle; on or within 50 feet of waterways within the city limits.
