December 5-11, 2016

On December 5, 2016, Palmer Police arrested LAUREL A. FLOOR, age 34 of Palmer, on a warrant for Failure to Comply with Conditions of Probation on an Original Charge of Driving Under the Influence. FLOOR was remanded to Mat-Su Pretrial with three days to serve, with bail set at \$750 thereafter.
