

PRESS RELEASE FOR JUNE 20-26, 2016

On June 20, 2016, Palmer Police responded to a motor vehicle collision on the Palmer Wasilla Highway near South Felton Street. Investigation revealed TIMOTHY EDWARD SANDSON, age 20 of Palmer, failed to yield to a vehicle operated by RUTH ANN REISTERER, age 53 of Wasilla, causing a collision which disabled both vehicles. No injuries were reported and the vehicles were removed from the scene by Matanuska Towing and Recovery. Mr. SANDSON was cited for Failure to Yield While Turning Left and Failure to Exhibit Proof of Insurance Upon Demand.
