May 9-15, 2016

On May 9, 2016, Palmer Police arrested Kristina Hawkins, age 22 of Palmer, on two warrants, totaling \$550, for failure to appear on original charges of Theft 4, Driving in Violation of Instructional Permit and No Liability Insurance. She was remanded to Mat-Su Pretrial.

On May 9, 2016, Palmer Police arrested Christopher Frank, age 24 of Palmer, for Disorderly Conduct. He was remanded to Mat-Su Pretrial where he was released on his own recognizance.

On May 10, 2016, Palmer Police received a report of a vehicle that had been damaged on April 17 in a business parking lot in Palmer. The damage occurred when the vehicle was struck by an unknown vehicle that left the scene. There were no reported injuries.

On May 10, 2016, Palmer Police arrested JACOB ALBERT MACK, age 32 of Wasilla on a probation violation and Driving Under the Influence. MACK was remanded to Mat-Su Pretrial where he was held without bail.

On May 11, 2016, Palmer Police arrested CHARLENE R. AZEAN, age 19 of Palmer, on 3 warrants totaling \$1000 for Failure to Comply with Conditions of ASAP, Failure to Appear at Change of Plea and Failure to Comply with Conditions of Probation all stem from original charges of Minor Consuming Alcohol. AZEAN was remanded to Mat-Su Pretrial.

On May 12, 2016, Palmer Police charged a juvenile male with Theft in the Fourth Degree after an investigation revealed he removed \$150 in cash from a desk at Palmer Junior Middle School. The charge was referred to the Department of Juvenile Justice.

On May 13, 2016, Palmer Police responded to a report of theft at the CARRS grocery store. Investigation continues.

On May 13, 2016, Palmer Police arrested CHARLES M. LESLIE, age 22 of Palmer, on a \$2500 warrant for Failure to Comply with Conditions of Probation on an Original Charge of Misconduct Involving a Controlled Substance 4 and a \$50 warrant for Failure to Appear at Arraignment on an Original Charge of Driving While License Revoked. LESLIE was remanded to Mat-Su Pretrial.

On May 14, 2016, Palmer Police received a report from EMILY N. ANDERSON, age 29 of Palmer, that her vehicle was damaged while it was parked at the Bishop's Attic parking lot. Investigation continues.

On May 15, 2016, Palmer Police issued a Summons to ANTHONY R. THOMAS, age 24 of Wasilla, for Driving in Violation of his Instruction Permit.
