On March 7, 2016, Palmer Police arrested ALEX R. ASCHENBRENNER, age 20 of Palmer, on a \$1000 warrant for Failure to Appear at an ASAP Hearing and Failure to Comply With Conditions of Probation on an Original Charge of Misconduct Involving a Controlled Substance 6. He was remanded to Mat-Su Pretrial.
