February 1- 7, 2016

On February 1, 2016, Palmer Police arrested Judith Ann Savage, age 52 of Palmer, on a \$1500 warrant for Failure to Appear for an original charge of Driving While License Revoked. She was remanded to Mat-Su Pretrial.

On February 1, 2016, Palmer Police arrested RHONDA RANEA RICE, age 40 of Palmer, for Disorderly Conduct. RICE was remanded to Mat-Su Pretrial where she was held overnight on \$100 unsecured cash performance bail.

On February 2, 2016, Palmer Police arrested EARL A. BROWN, age 38 of Palmer, for Assault 4 (Domestic Violence). He was remanded to Mat-Su Pretrial without bail.
