January 11, 2016 – January 17, 2016

On January 11, 2016, Palmer Police arrested MATTHEW DAVID LATHAM, age 40 of Wasilla, on a \$1,500 warrant for Endangering the Welfare of a Minor on an original charge of Criminal Nonsupport. He was remanded to Mat-Su Pretrial.
