September 25-October 1, 2017

On September 26, 2017, Palmer Police investigated a collision in the La Fiesta parking lot involving CHARLES J. DARNELL JR, age 52 of Palmer. No injuries were reported.

On September 27, 2017, Palmer Police forward charges to the District Attorney's Office on MIRANDA J. CRAIG, age 27 of Palmer, for Assault 4 and Violating a Domestic Violence Restraining Order.

On September 28, 2017, Palmer Police responded to a motor vehicle collision at the intersection of the Glenn Hwy. and E. Inner Springer Loop.
