August 28 – September 3, 2017

On August 28, 2017, Palmer Police arrested JORDEN THOMAS HEALY, age 21 of Palmer, for Driving Under the Influence and a \$100 warrant for Failure to Appear on an Original Charge of Minor Consuming Alcohol. HEALY was remanded to Mat-Su Pretrial.
