February 27-March 5, 2017

On February 28, 2017, Palmer Police arrested WALTER CUNNINGHAM, age 87 of Palmer, for Assault 4. He was remanded to Mat-Su Pretrial and held without bail.

On March 1, 2017, Palmer Police arrested MICHAEL J. VOLLEMA, age 56 of Glennallen, for Felony Driving Under the Influence. He was remanded to Mat-Su Pretrial where bail was set at \$5,000.

On March 1, 2017, Palmer Police arrested CHRISTOPHER GEORGE CRANFILL, age 45 of Palmer, for CRIMINAL TRESPASS, DISORDERLY CONDUCT, and INDECENT EXPOSURE. CRANFILL was remanded to Mat-Su Pretrial where he was released on his own recognizance when sober.
