

PALMER POLICE PRESS RELEASES FOR **March 22-28, 2021**

On March 22, 2021, Palmer Police arrested FA'AU'UGA SHANE MA'A FUIFATU, age 34 of Palmer, on a \$250 warrant for Failure to Appear for ASAP hearing on an Original Charge of Assault 4 DV. He was remanded to Mat-Su Pretrial.

On March 22, 2021, Palmer Police arrested RHONDA NEWMAN, age 37 of Wasilla, on a \$100.00 Warrant for Failure to Appear with an original charge of Driving on a Revoked License and No Liability Insurance.

On March 22, 2021, Palmer Police charged AMBER N. BOLINDER, age 41 of Palmer, with three counts of Misconduct Involving a Controlled Substance 3 and three counts of Misconduct Involving a Controlled Substance 5. Charges were forwarded to the District Attorney's Office.

On March 23, 2021, Palmer Police arrested KIRK L. JACOBSEN, age 55 of Palmer, for Violating a Domestic Violence Protective Order. Jacobsen was remanded to Mat-Su Pretrial where he was held without bail.

On March 24, 2021, Palmer Police arrested ROSEBUD L. SWEENEY, age 30 of Palmer, for Criminal Trespass 2. She was remanded to Mat-Su Pretrial Facility without bail by Magistrate Bauer.

On March 25, 2021, Palmer Police Summoned JOURDAIN K. WILSON, age 32 of Palmer, for Driving While License Suspended.

On March 25, 2021, Palmer Police began investigating an incident involving the theft of a debit card and several subsequent fraudulent purchases using the debit card totaling more than \$750.00. The investigation is ongoing

On March 26, 2021, Palmer Police responded to a two-motor vehicle collision with reported injuries on the Glenn Highway near W. Eagle Avenue. Investigation revealed MATTHEW J. COTE, age 39 of Sutton, was driving southbound on the Glenn Highway when slick conditions caused him to drive into the rear of a vehicle driven by

MARY E. CALLISON, age 54 of Palmer. Minor injuries were reported but all parties declined medical treatment at the scene.

On March 26, 2021, Palmer Police arrested AARON R. LASHBROOK, age 31 of Palmer, for Assault in the 4th Degree - Domestic Violence, Violating Conditions of Release, and Disorderly Conduct. He was remanded to Mat-Su Pretrial with no bail set per the bail schedule.

On March 27, 2021, Palmer Police began investigating numerous incidents in downtown Palmer where two individuals are believed to have trespassed into parked, unlocked vehicles and stole items. The investigation is ongoing.

On March 28, 2021, Palmer Police Summoned STACEY A. NEWMAN, age 65 of Palmer, for Criminal Trespass II.
