A pre-bid meeting will be held at Palmer City Hall, 231 W, Evergreen Avenue, Palmer, Alaska on **March 15, 2022 at 10:00am**.

This is a bonded, public works project. Contractors are required to be licensed by the City and State and shall comply with Title 36. A bid guarantee is required with each bid in the form and amount indicated in the Palmer Standard Specifications. Successful bidder will be required to provide a performance bond and a labor and material payment bond each in the amount equal to 100% of the contract price.

SPECIAL PROVISIONS

SECTION 95.01 LOCATION AND SCOPE

All proposed Work is located within the City of Palmer corporate limits and is more particularly located on the design drawings. The Work included under this Contract consists of furnishing all labor, materials, equipment, supervision, and other facilities necessary to successfully complete the Work set forth in the Drawings and specifications. It shall be the responsibility of the bidder to prepare his/her bid so that all materials and/or fittings shall harmoniously conform to the intent of the Contract Drawings, Specifications, and Special Provisions.

Below are the schedules of Work that are presented in the Bid Proposal of this Contract:

SECTION 95.02 REFERENCE TO CITY OF PALMER STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS

This Contract is subject to and hereby incorporates by reference the 2018 City of Palmer Standard Specifications, hereinafter referred to as CPSS; the Alaska Traffic Manual - Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices (MUTCD), with the Alaska supplement latest edition; and the International Building Code, latest edition adopted by City of Palmer. When conflicts exist between CPSS and MUTCD, the requirements of CPSS and these Special Provisions shall govern.

SECTION 95.03 TIME OF COMPLETION

Work under this Contract shall be "substantially complete," as defined by CPSS Section 10.05 Control of Work, Article 5.31 Substantial Completion, within 36 days of Notice to Proceed.

The Contract Completion Date on or before **August 5**, **2022**. Final Acceptance of the Work shall be obtained by the Contract Completion Date.

Award of this Contract is anticipated on April 26, 2022.

SECTION 95.04 MODIFICATIONS AND/OR ADDITIONS TO CITY OF PALMER SPECIFICATIONS

The following listed provisions of CPSS are amended as hereinafter stated:

A. DIVISION 10 STANDARD GENERAL PROVISIONS

SECTION 10.01 DEFINITIONS

Add the following definitions:

DOT&PF – The State of Alaska Dept. of Transportation & Public Facilities

Department – The City of Palmer Department of Public Works

PSS – Used interchangeably with CPSS to refer to the City of Palmer Standard Specifications.

SECTION 10.02 BIDDING REQUIREMENTS AND CONDITIONS

Article 2.1 Examination of Bidding Documents and Site

Delete the last paragraph and replace with the following:

The Contractor is required to protect, repair or replace existing improvements on private property that may be encountered during construction. Submission of a Bid is an admission that the Bidder has examined the site to determine extent of work required.

SECTION 10.03 AWARD AND EXECUTION OF CONTRACT

Article 3.4 Action on Bids

Delete the last paragraph and replace with the following:

The execution of this Contract is subject to availability of funding from City, and/or State grant sources. Award of a contract is contingent upon receipt of such funds. If sufficient funds are not received, this project may be canceled at no cost to the City of Palmer.

Article 3.6 Execution of Contract

Delete the first sentence of the fourth paragraph and replace with the following:

The Contractor will be supplied with one (1) electronic file (PDF format) of the conformed Contract Documents with half-size Drawings, exclusive of City of Palmer Standard Specifications, and one (1) set of full-size Drawings.

The Engineer's CAD files will not be provided to the Contractor.

SECTION 10.04 SCOPE OF WORK

Article 4.8 Work Incidental to the Contract

Delete the first paragraph and list and replace with the following:

Several items of Work, not covered in the Bid Proposal, will be considered incidental to the cost of the Contract. These items shall include, but are not limited to, the following:

- 1. Resetting disturbed property corners or monuments, except monuments identified on the Drawings to be reset.
- 2. Providing safe hauling and Traffic Control Plan, prior to beginning construction, for hauling and site access.
- 3. Post-construction cleanup.
- 4. Preparing and updating schedules.
- 5. Attending construction progress meetings with the Owner and the Engineer.
- 6. Jobsite safety.
- 7. Pot holing to identify the location of buried utilities, if needed.
- 8. Disposal of excess or unusable excavation and pavement.
- 9. Maintenance and Drainage per Section 10.04, Article 4.14.
- 10. Final restoration of all disturbed areas to smooth contours and restoration of existing drainage patterns and vegetation.
- 11. Saw cutting of pavement.
- Providing tack coat on vertical surfaces of pavement and concrete prior to paving.
- 13. Working in proximity to existing buried and aboveground utilities and protection and repair of damage caused by the Contractor.
- 14. Water for construction.
- 15. Additional temporary construction easements for Contractor material storage or staging yards.
- 16. Temporary Erosion and Sediment Control during construction.
- 17. Imported Classified Fill, if needed.
- 18. Surveying and laying out the work.
- All other items designated as incidental on the Drawings or specifications.
- 20. Preparation of a Quality Control Program and Quality Control Testing.

Article 4.12 Public Convenience and Access

Add the following after the third paragraph:

Traffic restrictions are not allowed during the Alaska State Fair. Contractor shall provide updates of planned activities weekly or more frequently as requested by the Engineer, for the purpose of updating the public through the City's web site.

Article 4.17 Utilities

Delete the first three sentences of the first paragraph and substitute the following:

Utilities are not shown on the Drawings.

Insert the following prior to the last paragraph:

The Contractor is hereby notified that certain utility companies may have facilities in the project limits. Contact numbers include, but are not limited to:

- Matanuska Telephone Association (907) 761-2553
- Matanuska Electric Association (907) 761-9302
- Enstar Natural Gas Company (907) 830-9065
- GCI Cable Company (907) 229-9176
- City of Palmer Department of Public Works (907) 745-3400 (streetlights, water, sewer and storm drain)

Contractor shall notify and coordinate with utility companies for all Work in close proximity to their respective facilities.

SECTION 10.05 CONTROL OF WORK

Article 5.3 Construction Progress Schedule and Schedule of Values

Delete the first paragraph and replace with the following:

Within five (5) calendar days after execution of contract, the Contractor shall submit to the Engineer a Construction Progress Schedule in the form of a time-scaled bar chart or Critical Path Method (CPM) schedule, the elements of which shall be the significant bid items, at a minimum. Additional items shall be added to represent other significant features of the Work, such as the submittal schedule, material procurement and freighting. Weather and ground condition restraints, work suspensions and other significant influences on the Contract amount and/or time for completion of the Work shall be shown. The initial schedule shall be for the entire Work, and shall extend through project completion. The schedule shall be revised and submitted at two-week intervals with a report identifying changes to activities (start, finish, duration, or critical path), changes to Contract Time, and methods to recover from delays for each activity.

Article 5.7 Materials

Add the following to the end of the Article:

The Contractor shall limit his borrow and aggregate sources to existing and legally permitted sources.

Article 5.8 Testing of Materials

Delete the second to last paragraph which begins "As part of the overall...".

Article 5.9 Contractor's Authorized Representatives and Employees

In the first sentence, delete "Notice to Proceed" and replace with "execution of the contract".

Article 5.10 Subcontracting

Delete the following:

"2. Within ten (10) days after the effective date of the Notice-to-Proceed, and prior to commencement of the Work, the Contractor shall provide..."

And replace with:

"2. Within two (2) days after bid opening, and prior to commencement of the Work, the apparent low bidder shall provide..."

Article 5.27 Liquidated Damages

Delete the entire first paragraph and replace with the following:

The Owner may withhold from any progress payment the sum of \$500.00 per day as Liquidated Damages for each and every calendar day that Substantial Completion is delayed beyond the Substantial Completion Date. After Substantial Completion, the Owner may withhold out of any progress payment the sum of \$500.00 per day as Liquidated Damages for each and every calendar day that Final Acceptance is delayed beyond the Contract Completion Date. If no money is due to the Contractor, the Owner shall have the right to recover said sums from Contractor, the Surety, or both.

Article 5.34 Substantial Completion

Delete the last paragraph and replace with the following:

For Substantial Completion, all work, including pavement markings, shall be complete such that all systems are functional for their intended use and provide for public safety.

SECTION 10.06 LEGAL RELATIONS AND RESPONSIBILITIES

Article 6.6 Permits

Add the following at the end of the article:

Contractor shall secure and pay for all permits and fees associated with this work, including but not limited to:

- Department of Labor and Workforce Development Notice of Work
- City of Palmer Road Closure Permit

Contractor shall coordinate with utilities and pay all fees associated with utility permits, relocations, inspection, or deposits.

Add the following new Article 6.19 Payments to Contractors and Subcontractors:

Article 6.19 Payments to Contractors and Subcontractors

Payment to Contractors and Subcontractors shall comply with the provisions of Alaska Statute 36, Section 36.90, Article 3 entitled "Public Construction Contract Payment."

SECTION 10.07 MEASUREMENT AND PAYMENT

Article 7.7 Final Payment

Delete Paragraph B and replace with the following:

B. Other contractually required documents noted in the contract, including Contract Completion and Acceptance Certificate and Contractor's Statement Concerning Claims, on the forms provided by the Owner; and

B. DIVISION 20 STANDARD CONSTRUCTION SPECIFICATIONS FOR EARTHWORK

SECTION 20.01 GENERAL

Article 1.6 Subsurface Investigation

Delete the second paragraph and replace with the following paragraph:

Subsurface Investigation was not performed for this project.

C. DIVISION 40 STANDARD CONSTRUCTION SPECIFICATIONS FOR ASPHALT SURFACING

SECTION 40.11 REMOVE AND REPLACE ASPHALT SURFACING

Article 11.1 General

Delete this Article and replace with the following:

The Work under this Section consists of performing all work required for removing, disposing of, and replacing existing surfacing or cold mix asphalt, including adjusting utilities, placing and grading Classified Fill and Backfill, Type IIA and Leveling Course, and replacing existing traffic markings, to the extent indicated on the Drawings, and as directed by the Engineer.

Article 11.3 Construction

Delete the second paragraph and replace with the following:

Contractor shall remove existing asphalt surfacing, regardless of thickness. Removal and replacement of backfill and Leveling Course will be to the extent indicated on the Drawings, and as directed by the Engineer.

Contractor shall grade and compact Leveling Course to prepare the area to receive asphalt surfacing, including furnishing and installing any leveling course as shown on the plans or as necessary to establish grade.

Add the following to the end of the article:

Provide imported fill material as needed to expand the radius approaches to the dimensions shown on the Drawings. Fill shall be Classified Fill and Backfill, Type IIA.

The fill and graded material shall be compacted to ninety-five percent (95%) of the maximum density, based on a roller pattern established in the field.

Article 11.4 Measurement

Delete this article and replace with the following:

Removing, disposing of, and replacing existing asphalt surfacing and cold mix asphalt, including adjusting utilities, placing and grading Classified Fill and Backfill, Type IIA and Leveling Course, and replacing existing traffic markings is measured per square yard, complete in place.

Article 11.5 Basis of Payment

Add the following payment items:

Square Yard
